- data for the Champlain region and for each of the five counties in Eastern Ontario
- comparisons across counties, the region and Ontario

#### **Community Information and Mapping System (CIMS)**

The CIMS initiative of the Social Planning Council of Ottawa allows agencies to bring their own data into a secure system and combine the information data with population health data that can be mapped as an aid for community-based research, planning and information sharing.
